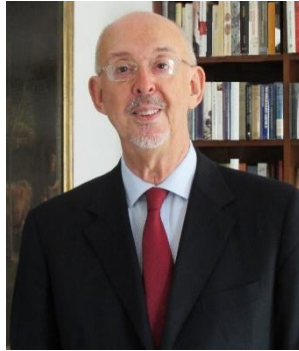

Sergio Marchisio is Full Professor of International Law at the Sapienza University of Rome, where he also holds courses on Space Law and Humanitarian Affairs. Previously, he was Professor at the Universities of Florence, Camerino and Perugia (1979-1997).

Member of the Scientific Board of the PhD in “Public, Comparative and International Law” at the Sapienza University and Member of the Academic Board of the Sapienza School for Advanced Studies. Since 1995, he is Adjunct Professor of European Union Law at Faculty of Law of the LUISS G. Carli University.

He is Director of the 2<sup>nd</sup> Level Master Course in International Protection of Human Rights, with the sponsorship of the United Nations Regional Information Centre (UNRIC), and Director of the Course on Refugees and Migrants at Sapienza University of Rome, in cooperation with the Office of the United Nations High Commissioner for Refugees (UNHCR), Caritas Roma, the Italian Council for Refugees (CIR), the Association for the Study of the World Refugee Problem (AWR Italy).

He is also Co-Director of the Master Course in Space Policy and Institutions, organized by National Research Council (CNR), Italian Society for International Organization (SIOI) and the Italian Space Agency (ASI). Member of the Scientific Committee of the Master IDEST *Droit des telecommunications et des nouvelles technologies* of Paris Sud, Faculté de droit Jean Monnet.

Founder and Former Director of the Institute for International Legal Studies of the National Research Council (ISGI-CNR), 1995-2011, he is now Associate Professor to the Institute. He supervised and edited the research on the Italian Practice of International Law, published in 1995 by CNR (I-VIII volumes).

In 2011-2014, he acted as Coordinator for the Research Unit “Sapienza” within the funded PRIN project on the Democratic Principle in the Development and Implementation of the International and European Economic Law. In 2007-2010 was UNDP Senior Legal Expert for LIFP Project on Environmental Legislation, implementing the Cooperation Agreement between Italy and Egypt.

Secretary General of the Italian Society of International Law (SIDI, 2001-2011); Member of the Italian Section of the International Commission on Civil Status of Strasbourg (CIEC); Correspondent Member of the International Institute for the Unification of Private Law (UNIDROIT); Member of the Managing Council of the SIOI and of the Italian Consultative Committee on Human Rights. He is Italian Correspondent of the TMC Asser Institute, The Hague.

Member of the American Society of International Law (ASIL) and of the *Société française de droit international* (SFDI). Since 2010 he is Member of the Board of Directors of the International Institute for Space law (IISL), confirmed in September 2013. Full Member of the International Academy of Astronautics (IAA).

Member of the *Académie de l'air et l'espace* (ANAE) and of the London Institute of Space Policy and Law. Member of the Board of Editors of scientific reviews such as *The Aviation and Space Journal* and *International Order and Human Rights*.

In 2011, he received the Award IAA for Social Sciences for his contribution on Space Law. In 2015, he received the IISL Distinguished Service Award for his distinguished leadership in the development of international space law and institutions and his leading role for advancing international space law in the United Nations and other intergovernmental bodies.

Since 2007, he is Chairman of the European Centre for Space Law (ECSL) within the European Space Agency (ESA). Since 1997, he is Italian Delegate to the UN Committee on the peaceful uses of outer space (COPUOS, Vienna), where he served as Chairman of the Legal Subcommittee (2004-2006). In 2010, he was elected co-chair of the Expert Group D (legal) of the Working Group of the Scientific and Technical Subcommittee (STSC) on the Long term Sustainability of the Outer Space Activities (LTSSA).

Legal Advisor of the General Directorate for Political Affairs and Security of the Italian Ministry of Foreign Affairs and International Cooperation. Italian Delegate to the European Union Council's CODUN Space and Member of the Task Force of the EEAS-EU for the International Draft International Code of Conduct on Space Activities (ICoC), he follows the diplomatic on-going process for the adoption of the Code. In 2015, he has been Chair of the Multilateral Negotiations on an International Code of Conduct for Outer Space Activities, held at the United Nations Headquarters in New York, on appointment of the High Representative of the European Union for Foreign Affairs and Security Policy.

In 2012, he has been appointed by the UN Secretary General member of the Group of Governmental Experts (GGE) on Outer Space Transparency and Confidence-Building Measures established by UN General Assembly resolution 65/68. The GGE Report was adopted by *consensus* with the resolution 68/50 of the UN General Assembly.

Italian Delegate for various international conferences such as the United Nations Conference on Environment and Development (Rio de Janeiro, 1992); the United Nations Diplomatic Conference of Plenipotentiaries on the Establishment of an International Criminal Court (Rome, 1998); Diplomatic Conference to Adopt a Mobile Equipment Convention and an Aircraft Protocol (Cape Town, 2001).

Between 2001 and 2012, he chaired the Committee of Governmental Experts entrusted to negotiate the UNIDROIT Space Assets Protocol to the Cape Town Convention on International Interests in Mobile Equipment. In 2012, he was elected Chair of the Commission of the Whole of the Berlin Diplomatic Conference, which adopted the Protocol.

He is Member of the Specialized Panel of Arbitrators of the Permanent Court of Arbitration established pursuant to the Optional Rules for Arbitration of disputes related to space matters.

Member of the Task-Force, appointed by Ministry of Foreign Affairs, with Ministry of Education, University and Research (MIUR) and Italian Space Agency, for the institution of the Italian Register of Italian Space Objects Register. Since 2014, he is Member of the Board of Directors of the Italian Space Agency.

Author of around 200 publications in International Law, Law of International Organizations, European Union Law and Space Law.
